Integrated Language Arts-We spent last week discussing maps and the seven continents. This week we will read Disney's Cinderella and use it to compare/contrast "Yeh-Shen", the Chinese version. Students will also be learning about Europe and China, and keeping notes in our "suitcases".

Math- We are skipping to Chapter 9 to learn about telling time to the hour and half-hour. We will study Lessons 9.6-9.8 Our test will be on Thursday, October 18th.
