



Jackson High School *Science National Honor Society*

Purpose

The purpose of Science National Honor Society is to recognize high achievement in upper level Science courses at the secondary level and to promote growing interest in scientific fields of study.

Academic requirements

- A) 3.67 GPA across all science courses and 3.5 GPA for all courses (unweighted GPA)
- B) Current enrollment in at least one lab based honors science class (AP Physics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Environmental Science, Organic & Materials Science, or equivalent CCP)
- C) Currently in the 11th or 12th grade

Other considerations:

Candidates have established or are working toward the following personal goals:

Personal Qualities

- Respect the rights and dignity of all people.
- Value honesty.
- Demonstrate leadership qualities.
- Accept responsibilities.
- Work well with others.
- Show respect for others and their opinions.
- Are positive role models.

Benefits

- Official recognition that can be included on college applications
- Program recognition at graduation for active members
- Possible eligibility for scholarships and national awards

Additional Information

- If students have questions about *Science National Honor Society*, they should see the chapter adviser.
- Applications will be reviewed by JHS Science teachers and administration.
- New members will receive an acceptance letter.
- The cost of membership is a fee of \$20.00 due upon notification of acceptance. Students inducted during their Junior year, will only owe \$15.00 their Senior year.
- Membership terminates if:
 - The student is no longer enrolled in an upper level lab based science course.
 - The student's science cumulative GPA falls below a 3.67, or overall GPA falls below a 3.5.
 - The student fails to fulfill the 10.0 science service hours and 1 article presentation (per year).
 - The student does not actively attend and participate in 70% of the yearly meetings.

Deadline for application: October 1 (of current school year) by 8:00 am (Pages 2-4 are Due)
