JAGS Qualification Application Deadline: Wednesday, February 6, 2019, by 10:00am.

All complete qualification applications received before the deadline will receive full and equal consideration. Completed JAGS applications received after the deadline will be considered on a space available basis. Students with incomplete applications, negative feedback on their teacher evaluations, or unsatisfactory grades on their academic transcripts will not be considered for enrollment in the JAGS program. All applications should be turned in to Ms. Tonya Gillette, in the Guidance/Student Services office at JMMS, or to Kathryn Stone, in the JHS main office (mailbox), or electronically to kas2jc@jackson.sparcc.org.

Before you apply: The Jackson Academy for Global Studies is a unique school within a school focused on global studies. It is important for you to know about the rigor and requirements for students in this academy before you apply. Completing the application

- **Part 1 Student Information Form:** Complete all sections of this form.
- Part 2 Application Essay: You are required to submit an application essay. This essay should be handwritten or typed, as a sample of your best analysis, and no longer than 250 words.
- Part 3 JAGS Student and Parent Expectations: An agreement outlining the points of student and parent expectations will be reviewed and signed in the application process.
- Part 4 Recommendation Forms: Give the recommendation forms (included in this application packet) to your 8th grade (your 9th grade teachers if you are applying as an incoming Sophomore) English, Science and Social Studies teachers. All three teacher recommendations are required. Each teacher may return the recommendations to you in a signed, sealed envelope. You will submit the three recommendations in the sealed envelopes with the rest of your completed application before or on the due date.

Part 5 – grade card, attendance record and other school information:

JAGS may use at least two years of grades (recommended minimum GPA of 2.8 for acceptance), attendance records, discipline and behavior records, and testing scores as additional factors for consideration of acceptance. Please include your most recent grade card (copy from the Home Access Center) with your application.
