

## NATURE'S CLASSROOM CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

### Bedding

Bring a pillow, a sleeping bag, and/or bedding. Pillows **will not** be furnished.

### Clothing

As an outdoor education program, we will be spending a considerable amount of time outdoors. Use discretion depending on the length of stay and time of the year. All suggested items should be marked with the student's name.

Jeans or pants	Raincoat or poncho
Heavy Shirts	Light shirt
T-shirts	Old, comfortable shoes
Sweater or sweatshirt	Pajamas
Underwear	Bathrobe
Socks	Plastic bag for dirty clothes
Shorts	Waterproof boots/Shoes to wear in creek
Warm jacket	Mittens
Hat	Backpack

### Toiletries

Two towels  
Washcloth/Soap  
Toothpaste/Toothbrush  
Comb/brush  
Shampoo

### Equipment

Sturdy well broken-in boots  
Water bottle  
Camera - *Disposable cameras with name labels are best. Campers can bring digital cameras but campers will be outside, even in the rain. FAA Camp is not responsible for lost/broken cameras.*

### Do NOT Bring

Cell Phones	Curling irons/Flat Irons
Food/Candy or Gum	Makeup
Flashlights	Hair spray/Gel
Fireworks	Jewelry
Electronics	Spray on body products
Money (Turn in to your teacher prior to arrival at camp.)	

**Bug repellents should be wipes or bands. If any spray is packed, it should be recorded on the health form and turned in with medication.**

Please pack sleeping bags and pillows in a plastic bag or luggage. Loose articles may get wet. It is nice to pack a few extra plastic bags for packing to go home.
