



Mrs. Coddington's Math Homework Policy

Daily

Math homework will be assigned most nights (Mon-Thurs). Students are expected to complete all questions that are assigned, then have them checked by a parent at home. **Answer keys are available on your child's Polaris account.** I will check the next day to be sure the homework is complete, then go over only the problems with which students had difficulty.

Weekly

Math morning work is assigned each week. Students can find this in their Polaris account, and are to complete the problems in their math journal. Morning work is due on the last day of each week, and we will check it together then. Students are allowed to work on this when they arrive in the morning, during student assist, and at home.

Monthly

Each month the students will receive a calendar to track their fact practice. The goal is 50 min per week, which can be completed however works best for your family. (10 minutes per night is ideal). *Students must have at least one hour per month for it to be accepted. This time should be separate from time spent on homework and morning work.* Students with 3 hours 20 min (50 min per week x 4 weeks) will also receive a small prize each month.

Each of the above assignments is considered a homework.

3 homework misses = 1 strike
