I. What is expected of you?

- A. ALWAYS come to class prepared: Have a pencil, your spiral notebook, your math folder, and your covered book with you for every class.
- B. ALWAYS be on time. Be in the room when the bell rings. Excessive tardiness will result in detention
- C. ALWAYS come to class ready to learn.
- D. ALWAYS be attentive and willing to participate.

II. What are a few of the rules?

- A. All of the rules in my classroom are built off of respect. Everyone is expected to respect the room, respect each other, and respect the building staff. Typically, any misbehavior can be seen as breaking one of my three rules of respect.
- B. You must comply with all school rules while in my classroom-no exceptions!
- D. Good behavior could result in Positives

III. What about homework?

- A. Homework is given nearly every day, and is a very important part of the class.
- B. Students will be given 10 points for every completed homework assignment. In order to receive full credit, students MUST show work and complete the problems.
- C. Half credit will be given to students who turn in their homework a day late. After one day, the grade will be entered as a 0.
- D. To succeed on tests and quizzes , you MUST complete your homework on a regular basis. Failure to do so will result in you not being able to use notes on that weeks test. Consistent failure to do work will result in a call or e-mail home.

IV. Will notebooks be needed?

- A. All students are required to have a Binder, spiral notebook **or** a folder for math class.
- B. Your notebook and folder should be for math class only! Organization is a key to success!
- C. All papers in your notebook and folder should have your name at the top right hand corner.

V. What if you are absent?

- A. If you are absent, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to see me for missed work.
- B. For missed work, it is your responsibility to turn it in.
- C. A great way to see what you missed or to review what was done in class will be to get on my website. The easiest way to do this is to go to the Jackson home page under high school and teacher websites.

VI. What about evaluations?

- A. Students will be evaluated on homework, quizzes, tests, and projects. There will typically be either a quiz or a test once a week (usually on Friday).
- B. There will be a few opportunities for extra credit, be sure to take advantage of these!
- C. Tests and quizzes should always be graded by the next day, and they will also be posted on Pinnacle immediately.
