Reading/ELA:

Students will describe the overall
structure of a story, including that the
beginning introduces the story and the
ending concludes the story. They will ask
and answer who, what, where, when, why
questions in a non-fiction text.

Writing:

Students will write a 5 sentence paragraph
using a topic sentence and correct capitals
and punctuation.

Math:

Students will be able to read and write
numbers to 1000 using base-ten numerals,
number names and expanded form.

Keep practicing those facts!

Science/Social Studies:

Students will be able to name and
demonstrate the 7 habits of a happy kid.
They will demonstrate responsibility.

Foundations:

Students will apply glued and welded sounds
to encode and decode words.
