

Arrow Cards Draw

2 players

Materials-

- One set of arrow cards for each group

How to Play:

- 1- Place all tens and ones arrow cards face down on the table.
- 2- Each student draws one arrow card of each size. (1 tens card and 1 ones card)
- 3- Students will build the number with the arrow cards.
- 4- Each student reads his or her number and builds the number with base-ten blocks.
- 5- The student with the largest number gets all the arrow cards from each player.
- 6- The winner is the student with the most arrow cards at the end of the game.

Intended Learning:

- To learn the value of each place. To link quantities and numerals. To read numerals.

Extensions:

- Extend the activity by including the hundreds arrow cards.
- Extend the activity by including the thousands arrow cards.
