

Dot Snap

2 players

Materials- Double ten dot cards, numeral cards 10 to 20 (2 sets)

How to Play:

1- The cards are shuffled and divided between two players. Players keep their cards face down in a stack.

2- Youngest player goes first by putting their top card face up in the middle between both players.

3- Player 2 goes next and plays their top card on a new stack to the right of the other card.

4- If this card matches the card already showing, the players try to be the first to put their hand on the stack and call "Snap!" The player that does this, gets all the cards in the middle, and plays a new card in the middle.

5- If the card doesn't match, the next player plays the top card from their stack on the growing middle pile.

6- The game continues until one player has all of the cards.

Intended Learning: To learn addition in the range 1 to 20

Modifications: Students can play the same game with numeral cards 0 to 10
