*Treasurer Report – We took in over \$1000 for Jazz Desserts and netted about \$150. The booster equipment budget over due to purchases of walkie talkies and over on Executive Expenses because we had to pay for the band photo collage. We will be changing the band travel account to a checking account – not money market. We sent requested info from the Board of Education including officers and profit and loss statements.
