**G. GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION**

1. Earning a Position and Grades:

Grades will be based on music memorization, marching fundamentals and attendance at rehearsals and performances. All Rehearsals and performances are required. Should a conflict arise, please inform a member of the band staff as soon as possible.

Alternate status: Should a student not meet the music and/or marching requirements for performance, they will be placed on alternate status. This means that they will still attend the performances but will not be an active marching member of the ensemble until their music and/or marching improve.

1. Rehearsal Attire: School dress code applies – shorts of proper length, t shirt (no straps less than 2 inches wide, no side cut-away t-shirts), socks and tennis shoes.
2. Care of self (proper hydration, sunscreen, and diet) and care of equipment are expected.
3. Drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. Strictly prohibited by Jackson Board of Education Policy and Jackson H.S Code of Conduct.
4. Purchases: white marching shoes, black socks, white gloves, purple t-shirt, uniform usage fee, garment bag.
5. All are available through the booster club on uniform distribution night. Student account may be used.
6. Approximate cost for Freshman -\$130 including uniform purchases and booster fundraiser.
