**RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING SOLICITATION OF BIDS FOR THE
ART ROOM AND TEAM MEETING/LOCKER ROOM PROJECT**

The Superintendent requests authority to solicit bids for the Art Room and Team Meeting/Locker Room Project.

Background:

1. The Board has previously identified a need to construct an art room and an athletics team meeting/locker room at Jackson Memorial Middle School (the "Project") and previously procured Sol Harris/Day Architecture (the "Architect") to design the Project.
2. The Architect has prepared the drawings and specifications for the Project and, upon approval, the District will publically advertise the availability of a contract for the construction of the Project and solicit sealed bids, in compliance with Section 3313.46 of the Revised Code.
3. Subject to the Board's right to reject all bids, on the date specified in the bidding documents, the District will open and tabulate the bids received and determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; once identified, a contract with the selected contractor will be presented to the Board for consideration and approval.

The Jackson Local School District Board of Education resolves as follows:

1. The Board authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to solicit bids for the work in compliance with Section 3313.46 of the Revised Code.
2. The Board further authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to place the required legal notice to solicit bids for the Project, and to carry out the bid process, in accordance with state law.


