- A. A special session of the Jackson Local School District Board of Education was held Tuesday, July 23, 2024, at 8:00 a.m. at Jackson Local Schools District Office. The following members were present: Gindlesberger, Goff, Jones, Wright and Winkhart.
- B. President Wright led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- C. **Welcome and Celebration of Achievements**

- **Social Media Statistics:** The board was updated on key social media metrics, illustrating the district's online engagement.


H. **Cory Davies' planned Safety and security presentation was postponed due to time constraints.**
