



JMMS Ski Club 2023-2024

- The JMMS Ski Club will be going to Brandywine on 5 Thursdays this winter.
- Bus leaves from JMMS at 3:15 pm and returns at 9:00 pm.
- Sign ups will be through Boston Mills Brandywine (BMBW) AND JMMS this year.
 - **Step 1**: Turn in your transportation fee (\$110- a check made payable to Jackson Local Schools) and paperwork to your

grade specific advisor (see list below).

- *If you have a season pass (Ohio Pass, Epic Local, Epic), you will still need to pay the transportation fee and turn in the paperwork.
- **Step 2**: Use the access code, provided by the advisor when the transportation fee and paperwork are turned in, to sign-up on BMBW's website. This cost is \$320.
 - * Season Pass holders do not need to register through BMBW for the ski club program.
 - *Season Pass holders are not able to take the lessons.
- **Step 3**: Email or give the confirmation number (received once you are enrolled through BMBW) to your grade specific advisor.
- Your Thursday night Ski Club card is good **only** on the 5 Thursdays that JMMS goes to Brandywine.
- <u>Helmets are required</u>. You must own your own helmet or rent one weekly from Brandywine once we arrive there. (\$12 to rent each week). It is suggested to simply buy your own from Amazon or Play it Again Sports.
- This is a **no refunds** program. In the event of an injury prior to or at the onset of the program, families may choose to submit their request, with medical documentation, to resort leadership. There will be no refunds due to illness and/or quarantine.
- Spots are limited. Sign up as soon as possible!
- Starting this year, BMBW is completely CASHLESS. Students can buy gift cards at the ticket window, but should have alternative ways of purchasing items as necessary.

CLUB CONTRACT & RULES

- 1. All Ski Club forms and payments must be turned in to Mrs. Dimengo in room 275 (6th grade) or Miss Nousek in room 257 (7th & 8th grade) starting Wednesday, November 1st through Friday, December 8th, 2023. This includes your transportation fee AND confirmation of enrollment through the BMBW website.
- 2. Students should plan to meet near the Purple Gym (Door 20E) entrance or in the Northwest Parking area by 3:00 p.m to load equipment and take attendance. Buses will depart the Jackson Memorial Middle School Northwest Parking area at exactly 3:15 p.m. We will return to this same parking area by 9:00 p.m. Please inform your ride to pick you up no later than 9:00 p.m. Failure to have a ride home secured could cause club member to lose their lift for the next scheduled session. We do understand that there can be extreme circumstances, and we will handle those as they occur. Please be considerate of all who are involved
- 3. All club members MUST ride the provided bus. Students who are caught riding to the resort with someone else will forfeit their lift ticket and privileges without refund from the school or resort.
- 4. Plan to bring a small snack with you on the bus to eat, or a packed dinner for at the resort. You can also purchase something there, however, it is now CASHLESS. Your small snack should be SMALL, not a large meal. Additionally, please refrain from eating dairy products on the bus.
- 5. The ski club trip is a school sponsored activity. All school rules and policies will be in effect and enforced. This includes alcohol, drug and tobacco policies as well as behavior and appropriate dress policies. Any violations could result in the loss of the student's lift ticket and privileges without refund for the next trip or the remainder of the season. Standard discipline actions may also be imposed by the school administration depending on the offense. While at the resort the management rules and policies will be in effect in addition to the school rules and policies.
- 7. It is very difficult to replace the lift ticket. The resort usually charges \$20.00 to replace a lift ticket, and that is usually only under certain circumstances.
- 8. Lessons and evaluations are encouraged as part of the school club program. Cards are scanned as a specific color at the end of the lesson or evaluation. Once a black sticker is earned the students are encouraged to continue lessons, but they are no longer mandatory. Returning members will begin in the category they completed last season.
- 9. The Jackson Memorial Middle School Ski/Snowboard session will end at 7:30 p.m. There will be one call over the P.A. System. Please keep track of the time. There are clocks at the top and bottom of all lifts. If you need time to get something to eat or drink or to use the restroom, please plan ahead. Also, please allow for time to return your rental equipment. Students must be on the bus by 8:00 p.m. Students who fail to report to the bus by 8:00 p.m. could have their lift ticket suspended for the next session without a refund. This is in consideration for the rest of the group and for the rides waiting back at the school. Please be considerate of all involved.
- 10. Please dress appropriately for skiing and/or snowboarding, as well as for the weather. A winter jacket, hat or cap, insulated gloves or mittens, a warm pair of socks and some type of snow pants are recommended. **Helmets are also required for participation in ski club**. You can rent or buy your own.
- 11. Always ski/snowboard under control. Be cautious and considerate of others. Know and follow the Responsibility Code of Skiers and Snowboarders and please follow it.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISKS & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT WARNING: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING!

- 1. "RENTER" MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL USING THE RENTED EQUIPMENT. I AM THE RENTER OR, IF THE RENTER IS UNDER 18, I AM THE RENTER'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN. I UNDERSTAND THAT SKIING, SNOWBOARDING, USING THE EQUIPMENT LISTED ON THIS FORM, TRANSPORTING EQUIPMENT, RIDING A SKI LIFT AND USING SKI AREA FACILITIES, FOR ANY PURPOSE (THE "ACTIVITY") IS HAZARDOUS AND PRESENTS A RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY OR DEATH.
- 2. I understand the risks of using the rental equipment and participating in the Activity and that RENTER EXPRESSLY ASSUMES ALL RISKS OF USING THE EQUIPMENT AND PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY, which include but are not limited to: Equipment malfunction, failure, or damage; improper use or maintenance of equipment; changing weather conditions; variations in terrain; existing and changing trail and surface conditions; rocks, stumps, trees, debris, water channels, erosion; collisions with natural or man-made objects; falling or loss of control; entanglements or falls from lifts; sickness; and the negligence of others. I understand this description of risks is not complete and voluntarily choose for Renter to use the equipment and participate in the Activity and expressly assume all risks of using the equipment and participating in the Activity, known or unknown, inherent or otherwise. I understand that Renter must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts in high altitude.
- 3. I agree to accept for use the equipment rented "AS IS" and WITH NO WARRANTIES and accept responsibility for the care of the equipment during the rental period. I HAVE NOT MADE ANY MISREPRESENTATIONS WITH REGARD TO RENTER'S HEIGHT, WEIGHT, AGE AND/OR SKIER TYPE and represent that Renter will be the only person using the equipment. I UNDERSTAND THAT THE BINDING SYSTEM CANNOT GUARANTEE THE USER'S SAFETY. The binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. I further understand that the downhill ski binding system DOES NOT REDUCE THE RISK OF ANY TYPE OF INJURY TO RENTER. I understand that in snowboarding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and other sports utilizing equipment with non-release bindings, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use. I agree to assume and accept any and all known and unknown risks of injury to Renter while using this equipment. If I am signing on behalf of a minor, I acknowledge that: 1) I have spoken to the minor Renter about the Activity; 2) the minor understands and appreciates the risks of using the equipment and participating in the Activity; 3) the minor has received instruction regarding the use of the equipment and understands its function; and 4) the minor has voluntarily decided to use the equipment participate in the Activity.
- 4. I understand that the use of a helmet is strongly recommended but that a helmet is NOT a guarantee of Renter's safety. I understand that helmets have limited shock absorption capability and that serious injury or death can result from both high- and low-energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.
- 5. In consideration for allowing Renter to use the equipment and participate in the Activity, I AGREE, to the greatest extent permitted by law, TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AGAINST AND TO HOLD HARMLESS, RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND AGREE NOT TO SUE Vail Resorts, Inc., The Vail Corporation, Trimont Land Company, Heavenly Valley, Limited Partnership, VR US Holdings, Inc., VR US Holdings II, LLC, VR CPC Holdings, Inc., VR NW Holdings, Inc., VR NE Holdings, LLC, Peak Resorts, Inc., each of their affiliated companies and subsidiaries, the resort owner/operator, land owner, activity operator, the equipment manufacturer, the United States and all their respective insurance companies, successors in interest, commercial & corporate sponsors, affiliates, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, and shareholders (each a "Released Party") FOR ANY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR EXPENSE, WHICH I OR PARTICIPANT MAY SUFFER, ARISING IN WHOLE OR IN PART OUT OF PARTICIPANT'S USE OF THE EQUIPMENT OR PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THOSE CLAIMS BASED ON ANY RELEASED PARTY'S ALLEGED OR ACTUAL NEGLIGENCE OR BREACH OF ANY CONTRACT AND/OR EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY. I take full responsibility for any injury or loss to Renter, including death, which Renter may suffer, arising in whole or in part out of the Activity. I agree to pay all costs and attorneys' fees incurred by any Released Party in defending a claim or suit brought by or on behalf of the Undersigned or as a result of the Renter's participation in the Activity and to INDEMNIFY THE RELEASED PARTIES FOR ALL LIABILITY AND CLAIMS, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES, ARISING FROM ANY MISREPRESENTATIONS IN OR FRAUDULENT EXECUTION OF THIS AGREEMENT.
- 6. I agree that any and call claims for loss, injury and/or death regarding an alleged incident shall be governed by the law of the state where the alleged incident occurred and that **EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION** shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction in the such state.
- 7. BY SIGNING ON BEHALF OF A MINOR RENTER, I REPRESENT THAT I AM THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE MINOR RENTER and acknowledge that Renter is bound by all terms of this Agreement. I understand that the minor would not be permitted to use the equipment or take part in any of the Activities unless I agree to the terms of this Agreement.
- 8. I understand that this Agreement will apply for each and every day Renter uses equipment or participates in any Activity during the applicable operating season. I agree to inform the Rental Shop immediately if Renter's height, weight, and/or skier type changes. I understand that this Agreement is a contract and, to the fullest extent permitted by law, shall be binding on me and my assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract between the parties.
