I. Course Description:

- Reading Intervention is designed to prepare you to begin a **successful high school career and beyond** through learning and practicing reading skills and strategies.
- You will develop reading **comprehension** skills through passages, short stories, drama, nonfiction selections and novels.
- You will be **pre-taught and retaught skills** learned in your English class.
- You will prepare for **standardized assessments**.

II. Expectations:

1. Demonstrate **RESPECT** for all *staff, students, property and yourself*. Disturbing class, sleeping, inappropriate behavior, not paying attention, being disrespectful of my other others' belongings, rude comments and complaining is **NOT acceptable**. Cell phones must be placed in the door organizer, unless otherwise directed, or they will be confiscated and taken to the office. When you **act** like an adult, you are **treated** as an adult.

2. Demonstrate **RESPECT** for your *work*. Put forth your **BEST** effort on each given assignment. Come to class ready to learn. *I expect involvement in all classroom activities*. 4. We will **not be working on homework** in this course. Although we will be covering skills learned in your English class, it is separate from your English class.
